What is Youth Library Council?

Youth Library Council, or YLC, is a group of school-aged youth that assists in various tasks at the library.

When is YLC?

We will meet on the 4th Tuesday of the month during the school year- September through April- followed by a YLC party in May. The meetings will be held at the main branch in DeRidder (205 S. Washington St.). Meetings will start at 4:30PM and last an hour.

Who is eligible?

The Youth Library Council is open for any students in grades 5 through 12 or the equivalent (public, private, home-school, etc.). Teamwork and the ability to follow directions are required.

What do I get out of it?

Volunteer hours for school will be awarded. Membership in YLC looks fantastic on college applications! Most importantly, you will receive the eternal and undying gratitude of the library's programming department.

What do you actually do?

Grab-n-Go kit prep, book weeding, alphabetizing, straightening, light program planning, book reviews, displays, bulletin boards, etc. Earn extra volunteer hours by helping with events such as Booregard and Carnival on the Lawn.

What if I can't make it to a meeting?

That's ok! We understand that you may have a scheduling conflict or you have a big test and need to study. We ask that you submit a book review by the next meeting to make it up. Book reviews can be hand written and turned in at the next meeting or typed and emailed to Mrs. Amanda.
